Mitsubishi Pavilion at Expo 2025 Osaka, Kansai, Japan Unveiling an Immersive Visual Experience, Introducing the Cast, and Presenting Staff Uniforms

The Mitsubishi General Committee for Expo 2025 Osaka, Kansai, Japan, chaired by Yoshiyuki Nojima (Representative Director, Executive Vice President, Mitsubishi Corporation) and consisting of 30 Mitsubishi Group companies, held an exclusive preview and briefing session for the Mitsubishi Pavilion on February 28, 2025.

At the pavilion preview event, the immersive visual experiences, including the pre-show and the main show, were unveiled for the first time. In addition, the original music composed by Takatsugu Muramatsu and the voice cast, featuring Natsuki Hanae, Saori Hayami, and Miyuki Sawashiro, were introduced. The official staff uniforms were also revealed on the same day.



The Mitsubishi Pavilion is designed around the concept of 'Keeping the World Vibrant' and presents an exhibition themed 'From the Unknown Deep Sea to the Distant Universe.' The dynamic and emotionally moving original soundtrack by Takatsugu Muramatsu, combined with the powerful performances of a renowned cast of popular voice actors, seamlessly integrates with the

visuals to create a uniquely immersive experience found only at the pavilion.

### <Uniform Design and Concept>

The uniforms of the Mitsubishi Pavilion are designed to embody its theme: "From the unknown deep sea to the distant universe. Epic journey through life." Inspired by the flow of water, the design symbolically represents the interconnectedness of life, Earth, and the future society.

### <Uniform Features>

- Gender-Neutral Design: A unisex design that ensures comfort for all, regardless of gender.
- Free Combination: Allows for flexible styling, respecting individuality and diverse values.
- Eco-Friendly Materials: Made from high-performance fabrics that require no dry cleaning or ironing and are easy to clean.
- Sustainable Use: Promotes reuse and upcycling after the expo to reduce environmental impact.

### [Uniform Design & Coordination: Tomomi Yamamoto]

The originally designed vest symbolizes "Exploration into the Future," with flowing lines from the shoulders representing the "Flow of Water." Combining functionality and aesthetics, the design ensures that pavilion staff can work comfortably while maintaining a professional look. The uniform conveys warmth and reassurance to visitors, intuitively reflecting the worldview of the Mitsubishi Pavilion.



At the briefing session following the preview event, Tomoyuki Kato (Chief Creative Director, Dentsu Live),
Tomomi Yamamoto (Staff Uniform Design & Coordination), and Hajime Omino (Executive Director, Mitsubishi
Pavilion) took the stage to introduce the main show visuals, uniforms, and operational staff.
